



Anti-Bribery and Corruption Policy (ABC Policy)

Sunway University is committed to practice a zero-tolerance policy against all forms of bribery and corruption. The University is committed to conducting its business in accordance with all applicable laws, rules and regulations at the highest ethical standards.

As a conscientious employer, all employees and associates of the University must not offer, promise or give a bribe to anyone, and must not request, agree to accept or take a bribe from anyone. The purpose of this policy is to provide guidance to all the employees of the University and its associates concerning how to deal with bribery and corruption issues that may arise in the course of business.

The University is committed to take all necessary measures to ensure that all parts of the organisation do not participate in corrupt activities. It reiterates the University's commitment to full compliance by its employees and associates with the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) Act 2009 and the MACC (Amendment) Act 2018 and any other local anti-bribery or anti-corruption laws that may be applicable.
